Key Stage 2 Designated Provision

The KS2 Designated Provision class is for pupils with cognition and learning difficulties. There are currently 10 children in the class with a teacher and two teaching assistants.

Individual education programmes are planned, implemented and evaluated on a termly basis providing differentiation in the basic skills of literacy, numeracy, expressive and receptive language, attention control and concentration and independent learning skills.

The curriculum implemented to the class is delivered through cross-curricular teaching, based around picture books, which centres on social and emotional aspects of learning.

Where appropriate, children integrate with children from the mainstream classes for maths, assemblies, residential visits and music.

Our recent peer review showed that ***“Teachers have high expectations of all pupils. They plan and teach lessons that enable pupils to learn well. Teachers effectively check pupils’ understanding throughout lessons.”***

We work closely with parents, using a home-link diary to communicate with families of children who travel to school by taxi.
